

NHADA Legal Defense Fund Step Procedure

STARTING POINT

All requests for Legal Defense Fund (LDF) monies must be made directly to the NHADA President.

APPLICATION

Dealers requesting funds must complete the Legal Defense Fund Application and submit, in writing, details describing how their particular case could impact all dealers in the state.

LDF COMMITTEE

The NHADA President is to copy the Legal Defense Fund Application and any additional materials submitted by the dealer and send to each member of the LDF Committee.

The LDF Committee would review the request, and the Chair would call a meeting. The LDF Committee would present their written recommendation to the NHADA Board of Directors.

RECOMMENDATION

All recommendations of the LDF Committee are submitted to the NHADA Board of Directors for their consideration.

NHADA BOARD ACTION B Decisions will be made within 90 days of receipt of requests.

The Board may consider each case submitted to them by the LDF Committee at either a regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Directors or a conference call approved by the NHADA Chair.

In each individual application, the NHADA Board decides amount and condition of the LDF participation made to the dealer.

The dealer submitting the request would be presented with the decision of the Board, in writing, from the NHADA President.

The LDF Committee or the NHADA Board of Directors may contact legal counsel at any time for advice. Expenses incurred by the LDF Committee/NHADA Board for legal advice are to be paid out of the restricted Legal Defense Fund.
